

We do not have a reported case in Algeria, but the statute is very clear on the obligation of waste producers to assure final and proper disposition of their wastes. The 2001 national law on waste is very explicit:

Article 7

Every generator and / or holder of waste shall ensure or ensure the recovery of waste generated by the materials it imports or sells and the products it manufactures.

Article 8

Where the generator and / or the holder of waste is unable to avoid generating and / or recovering his waste, he is obliged to insure or have insured, at his own expense, the disposal of his waste. in an environmentally sound manner, in accordance with the provisions of this Law and its implementation.

From Law No. 01-19 of 12 December 2001 on the management, control and disposal of waste. (French)
