

We do not have a specific reported case in Egypt, but the general legal requirements on waste producers are very detailed.

The standard for waste producers is set out in Law No. 4 of 1994, promulgating the Environmental Law and its Executive Regulation. (Arabic). Article 31 of the Prime Minister's Decree No. 338 of 1995 sets out the details of the requirements and establishes strict liability: "Those responsible for the production or handling of hazardous materials, whether in their gaseous, liquid or solid state, shall take all precautions to ensure that no environmental damage occurs." Waste producers must also submit an annual report on their programs to meet this standard: "Those responsible for the production and circulation of hazardous substances shall submit an annual report on their commitment to implement due precautions." Id. Violations of the provisions of Law No. 4 of 1994 also give rise to civil liability for damages to third-parties.

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
