The <u>National Board of Patents and Registration of Finland</u> [http://www.prh.fi/en.html] is the official register for Finnish companies. As well as information on registering a company, there is a Trade Register of 470,000 Finnish companies that can be searched via <u>BIS Search</u> [www.ytj.fi]. Information includes name of a business, trading names, company form, address, contact information, principal line of business. It also provides information on termination, interruption of trade, bankruptcy, liquidation or reorganisation proceedings. Free of charge and available in Finnish, English and Swedish. Most businesses must submit their annual accounts to the register. Further information can be obtained from the <u>Trade Register</u> [http://www.prh.fi/en/kaupparekisteri.html] "The obligation to submit the financial statements for publishing by the Trade Register varies by type of business All financial statements submitted to the PRH are public documents, and can be purchased on our Virre Information Service (Financial statements search)."

Company information is available from the <u>Finnish Business Information System</u> [<u>http://www.ytj.fi/english/</u>], and can also be obtained via the <u>European Business Register</u> [<u>http://www.ebr.org/</u>] (EBR).
