The [Brønnøysund Register Centre](http://www.brreg.no/english/) [http://www.brreg.no/english/] is a government body under the Norwegian Ministry of Trade and Industry which consists of a number of national registers. “Pursuant to the Act relating to Company Accounts, all private and public limited companies, savings banks, mutual insurance companies and petroleum enterprises are obliged to submit their annual accounts, including the auditor's report, to the Register of Company Accounts. All accounts received will be announced after registration and all subsequent information will be made available to the general public. “
