The most important and potentially, most risks, involves managing of the waste that is generated at all stages of the manufacturing (including unwanted/end of life products) and it is important that these are managed properly as the liabilities extends beyond the organization's fence line, and that the responsibility extends forward to include responsible management, transport, recycling and treatment/disposal of all "wastes and spent materials" generated. Mr Chng's presentation will look at options available to manage these issues, to include actions available to them, monitor, and manage suppliers
